


Atlassian Confluence in docker container

sudo mkdir -p /docker/confluence
sudo docker run -v /docker/confluence:/var/atlassian/application-data/confluence --name="confluence" -d -p 8090:8090 -p 8091:8091 atlassian/confluence-server
```
